

Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply:

- 1 All visitors must wear closed in shoes or gumboots (jandals and bare feet will not be permitted).
- 2 As these are working farms, animals will not be permitted onto any farm under any circumstances. We also recommend that you do not bring wheelchairs, pushchairs, buggies, prams or similar, as they may be difficult to manoeuvre around the farm.
- 3 Children must be fully supervised at all times while you are on the farm. There must be at least one adult for every three children under the age of 13.
- 4 You must not touch any animals on farm at any time. You must not attend a farm if you have had any contact with a sick animal in the period 1 December to 10 December 2017.
- 5 You must comply with all rules, including health and safety rules, of the farm you are visiting. These will be provided in the email confirming the address of the farm you are allocated to visit and will also be available at the farm when you visit.
- 6 You must make your own way to and from the farm you are allocated to visit. There will be car parking facilities at each farm.
- 7 Fonterra may cancel or change the date or time of Open Gates, or refuse any individual or group entry to a farm, for any reason whatsoever.
- 8 Your attendance at Open Gates is at your own risk. Fonterra disclaims, to the maximum extent permitted by law, all liability arising from or in connection with Open Gates, including without limitation, any injury, illness or accident resulting from or occurring during Open Gates. You may be liable for any damage you cause to a farm during Open Gates.
- 9 Fonterra is committed to protecting your privacy. Fonterra will collect and use your details for the purposes of running Open Gates and for contacting you after Open Gates.
